The Sault Area Hospital currently has two CT scanners in operation to serve our community. One was purchased when our Hospital was built in 2011, and the other was moved from the old site on Queen Street. The two work together, 24 hours a day to

meet the Diagnostic Imaging needs of our community.

The older of the two is about to reach 10 years of operation and although it has put in thousands of scans annually, it will soon need to be replaced. The replacement comes to reduce risk of downtime (lengthening wait times) as well as to ensure our Hospital has the best technology available.
